Position Responsibilities

Community Alliance Church (CAC) NextGen Pastor is responsible for living out the mission of loving God, loving people, and making disciples of Jesus. This pastor will share strategic overall leadership with the elders, and will oversee operational leadership with the staff, while loving the church, orienting around the gospel, and diligently seeking to advance the disciple-making mission of Jesus through CAC. This pastor is expected to invest in Christ's mission in and through CAC by giving primary focus to:

- Preaching, Teaching, and Training
- Implement a system to recruit and train small group leaders.
- Oversee ministries for young married couples, single adults, youth and children.
- Evaluating the health of the ministries listed above and making adjustments/modifications as necessary.
- Manage group structure to connect kids and teenagers relationally with peers and leaders.
- Leverage digital strategies to enhance learning and relationships.
- Design strategic opportunities to help every parent stay connected.
- Provide resources and experiences that help parents win with their own kids.
- Leverage resources and strategies to keep parents inspired and informed.
