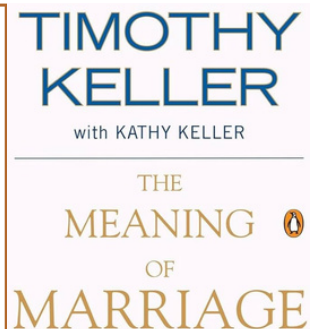
YOU AND ME FOREVER BY FRANCIS AND LISA CHAN

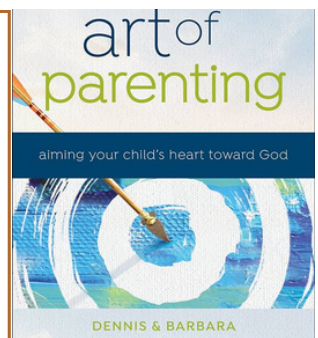
THE MEANING OF MARRIAGE BY TIMOTHY KELLER WITH KATHY KELLER

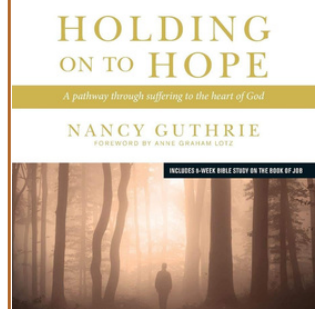
THE ART OF PARENTING BY DENNIS AND BARBARA RAINEY

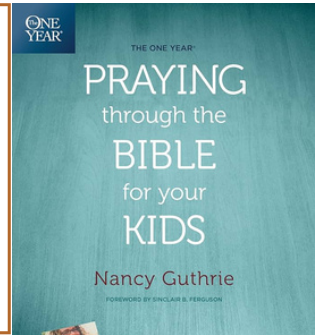

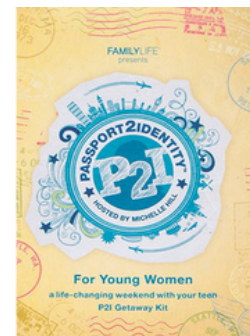
